ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Established in 1972 by Bastar Shiksha Samiti, The College began as a co-educational institution to serve the educational needs of the Bastar region. with a focused vision to promote women's education. It was converted into a women's college in 1978 with approval of the Higher Education Commissioner, Government of Madhya Pradesh and Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University.

The college holds the distinction of being the first and only women's college in the Bastar Commissionerate and was taken over by the Government of Madhya Pradesh in 1982. Recognized under the UGC Act, 1956 (2F & 12B), Institution is affiliated with Shahid Mahendra Karma University Bastar located in the heart of Jagdalpur, spreads over a 4.15-acre campus. The college offers undergraduate programmes along with postgraduate courses in five subjects - Political Science, Ancient Indian History, Anthropology, Home Science, and Sociology. Under the self-finance scheme, PGDCA is also offered. The institution is equipped with modern classrooms, laboratories, library, computer lab, sports facilities, and student support services, fostering academic excellence and holistic development of women learners. Hindi department of this college has completed two national workshop in the year 2005 and 2014 and a short research project approved by the UGC.
